

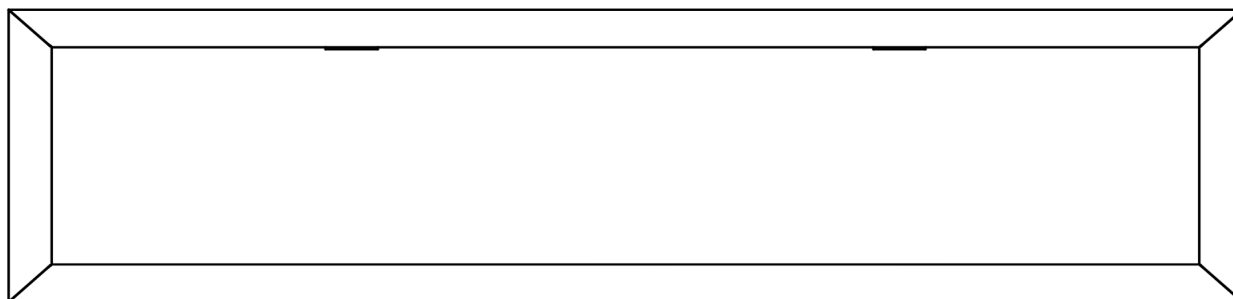

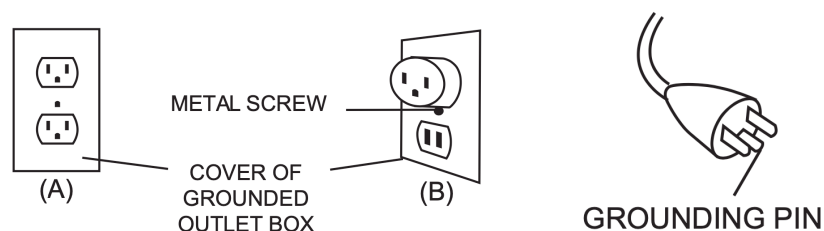
SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Read all instructions before using this heater!**
- This heater is **hot when in use**. To avoid burns, **DO NOT** let bare skin touch **hot** surfaces. If provided, use handles when moving this heater. Keep **combustible materials**, such as furniture, pillows, bedding, papers, clothes, and curtains at least **3 feet (0.9m)** from the **front of the heater** and **keep them away from the sides and rear**.
- **Extreme caution** is necessary when any heater is used by or near **children** or **invalids** and whenever the heater is left **operating and unattended**.
- **DO NOT** operate any heater with a **damaged cord or plug** or after the **heater malfunctions**, has been **dropped** or **damaged in any manner**. Discard heater or return to authorized service facility for examination and/or repair.
- **DO NOT** run **power cord** under carpeting. **DO NOT** cover power cord with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. **DO NOT** route power cord under furniture or appliances. Arrange power cord **away from traffic** area, and where it will not be tripped over.
- **DO NOT** insert or allow **foreign objects** to enter any **ventilation or exhaust opening**, as this may cause **electric shock** or **fire**, or **damage the heater**.

- **ALWAYS** plug heaters directly into a wall outlet/receptacle. **NEVER** use with an extension cord or relocatable power tap (outlet/power strip).
- **DO NOT** place the heater near a bed because objects such as pillows or blankets can fall off the bed and be ignited by the heater.
- **NEVER** use this heater in **bathrooms, laundry rooms**, or any other location where the heater could fall into a **bathtub** or **pool**, become damp, or come in contact with water.
- **AVOID FIRE!** Regularly inspect all air vents to make sure they are free from dust, lint, or other blockage. **Unplug the unit** and clean with a **vacuum ONLY**. **DO NOT** rinse or get wet.
- **NEVER** hang this unit on a wall **directly below an electrical outlet**.
- **NEVER** permanently install in a recessed area of the wall. This may result in **blocked air flow, overheating, or fire**.
- **ALWAYS** secure to wall framing before use.

- **ALWAYS** turn this heater off before unplugging it from the outlet.
- **ALWAYS disconnect** this unit from the **power** supply **before** performing any assembly or cleaning, or before relocating the electric fireplace.
- **NEVER** leave this heater unattended. **ALWAYS** unplug this heater when not in use.
- **ALWAYS** store this heater in a dry location. **NEVER** use the fireplace if it has become wet.
- **ONLY** use this heater on a **120V AC 15-Amp circuit**. **NEVER overload the circuit**. If this heater trips the circuit breaker, unplug all other appliances on the same circuit before the next use. Avoid plugging other appliances into the same circuit as this heater.
- **NEVER** plug this heater into an outlet that is **old, cracked**, or has any **loose wires or connections**. Plugging this heater into a faulty outlet could result in **electric arcing** within the outlet that could cause the **outlet to overheat or catch fire**.
- **ALWAYS** check your heater cord and plug connections with **each use!**
 1. **MAKE SURE** the plug fits tight in the outlet! Faulty wall outlet connections or loose plugs can cause the outlet to overheat.
 2. **Heaters draw more current** than small appliances. **Overheating** may occur even if it has not occurred with the use of other appliances.
 3. During use **check frequently** to see if the **plug outlet or faceplate is HOT!** If the outlet or faceplate is **HOT, discontinue use immediately** and have a qualified electrician inspect and/or replace the faulty outlets.

This heater has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). As a safety feature to reduce the risk of electrical shock, this plug is intended to fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.

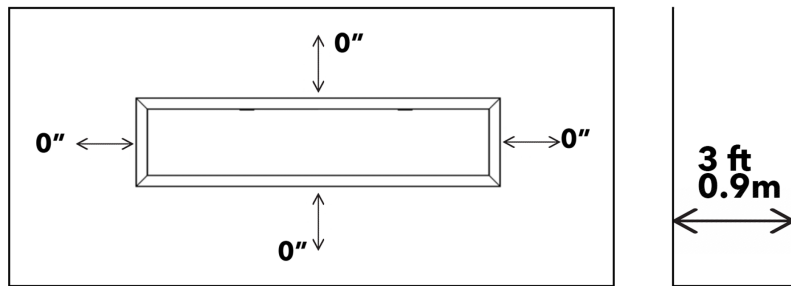
INSTALLATION

LOCATING YOUR ELECTRIC FIREPLACE

Your new electric fireplace may be installed virtually anywhere in your home. However, when choosing a location, ensure that the general instructions are followed. For best results, install out of direct sunlight. Power supply service must be either completed or placed within the electric fireplace prior to finish to avoid reconstruction.

MINIMUM CLEARANCE TO COMBUSTIBLES

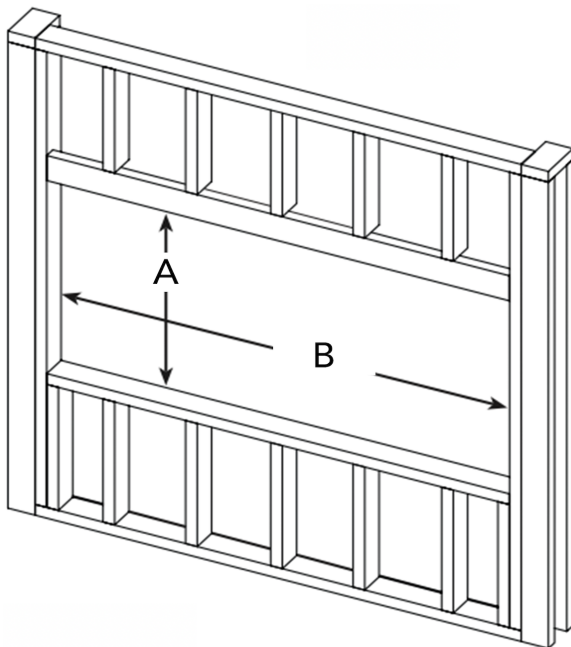

Note: Ensure that you leave adequate room to remove and replace the front screen or optional front.

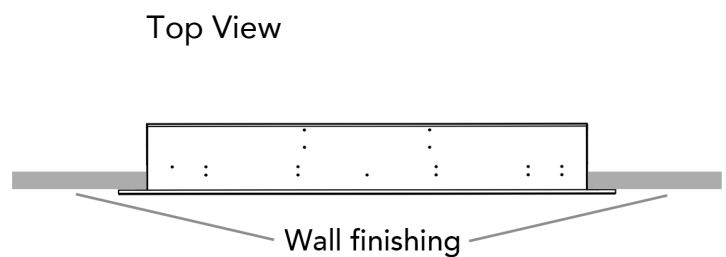
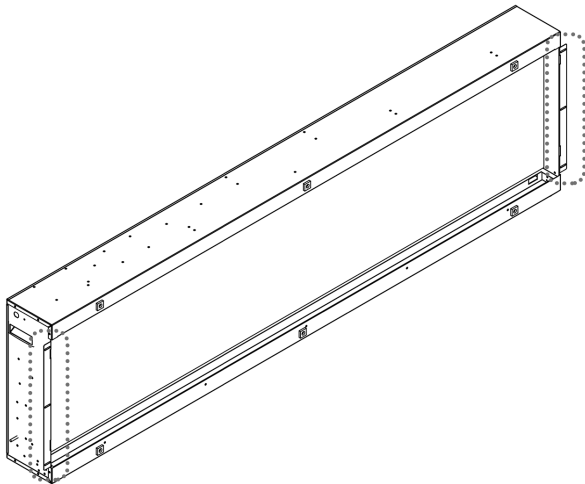

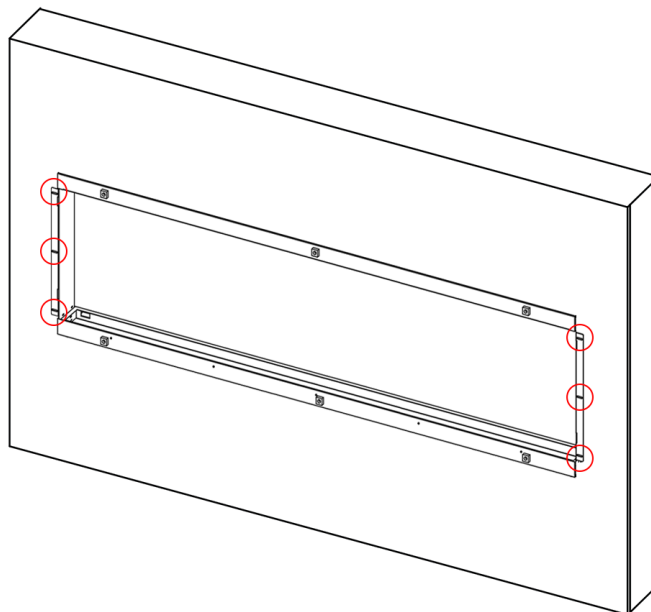
Framing Procedure

1. Build frame according to framing dimensions on previous page and ensure power source is available
2. Remove front glass and trim piece, and set aside (refer to page 8 for instructions)
3. It is recommended to install the fireplace **after** finishing the wall to ensure the side brackets sits flush with the wall finishing



4. After wall has been finished, place fireplace into wall framing and use framing screws to secure the side brackets to wall. Then install front glass and trim piece.

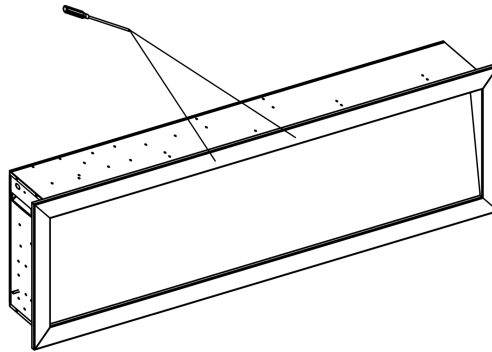
NOTE: There are four rubber feet on the bottom of the fireplace that can be removed before installation



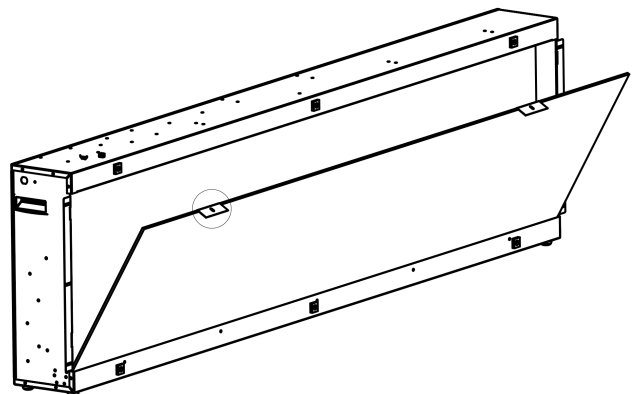
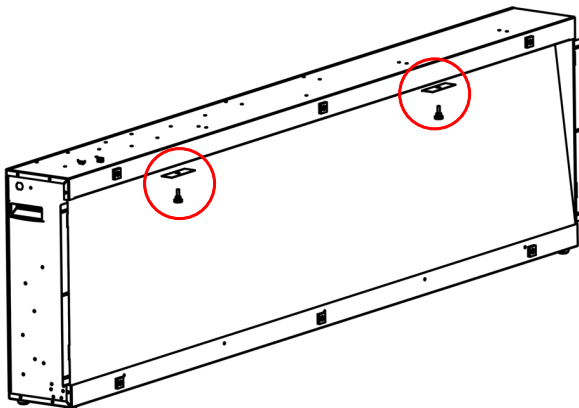
PLACING MEDIA ON FLAME BED

Removing Front Glass

1. Locate the heater louver in the middle of the fireplace underneath the trim. Remove the heater louver by removing the two screws holding it in place, then remove front trim piece

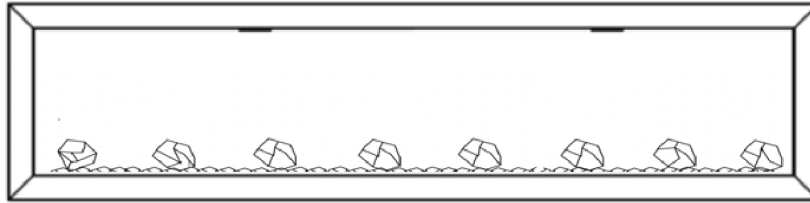


2. Loosen and remove the two front glass clips under the trim. You can use the clips to hook on and remove the glass. Set glass aside in secure location.



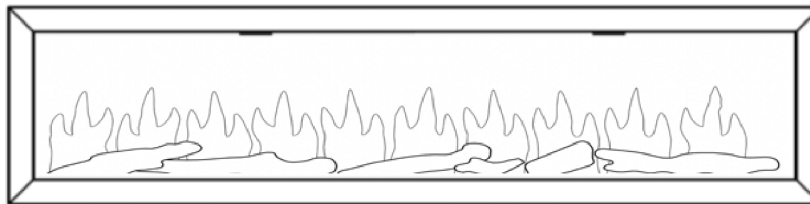
3. For crystal effect:

Carefully spread the small clear crystal stones across the fuel bed. Then evenly arrange the larger crystal stones starting along the inset window ledge at the front of the firebox.



For log effect:

Carefully spread the small clear and semi-painted crystal stones across the fuel bed. Arrange the logs and place the small semi-painted and clear crystal stones in between the log layout.



HARDWIRE OPTION

Plug-in

You may run the power cord out of the framed wall opening to an existing outlet or install an outlet on a nearby wall stud within the wall). If the cord is not long enough to reach the outlet, a grounded extension cord minimum AWG No. 14 wiring and rated to a minimum of 1875 watts may be used.

Hard-wire

A qualified electrician may remove the cord connection and wire the appliance directly to the house hold wiring. The appliance must be electrically connected and grounded in accordance with local codes.

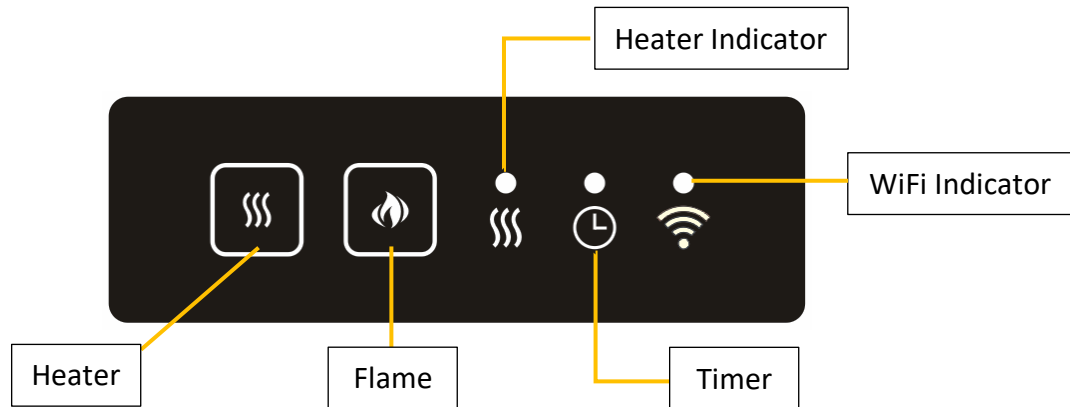

OPERATION

This appliance can be operated by remote control and onboard buttons, however onboard buttons have limited functions. A beep should be heard when the power is first applied.

1. ONBOARD BUTTONS

The onboard buttons are located under the trim on the top left.



Press the **Flame** button to turn on/off the flame LED and cycle through flame brightness levels High/Medium/Low.



Press the **Heater** button to turn on/off the heater and cycle through heat levels High/Low. Heat level is indicated by the **Heater Indicator** light.



Red Indicator: High heat
Blue Indicator: Low heat
Indicator Off: Heater off



Indicator On: Heater timer is set

2. WIFI CONFIGURATION



With the fireplace turned off (flame off, heater off) and supplied with power, press and hold the **Heater** button for 5 seconds, then release. The **WiFi Indicator** will begin flashing indicating the fireplace is ready for setup in the Dynasty App.

The **WiFi Indicator** will remain on once connection to the app is successful.

3. REMOTE CONTROL

In order to protect the product from becoming too hot, there is a 10s delay when turning on the heater; also, there is a 10s delay when turning off the heater fan.

- **Make sure the batteries are installed properly in the remote control.**
- **The effective range of the remote control is up to 4 meters or 13 feet.**

OPERATION

Cleaning



NEVER immerse in water or **spray with water**. Doing so could result in **electric shock, fire, or personal injury**.

Metal:

- Buff using a soft cloth, slightly dampened with a mild cleaning solution if needed.
- **DO NOT** use brass polish or household cleaners as these products will damage the metal trim.

Glass:

- Use a good quality glass cleaner and dry thoroughly with a paper towel or lint-free cloth.
- **NEVER** use abrasive cleansers, liquid sprays, or any cleaner that could scratch the surface.

Plastic:

- Wipe gently with a slightly damp cloth and a mild cleaning solution and warm water.
- **NEVER** use abrasive cleansers, liquid sprays, or any cleaner that could scratch the surface.

Vents:

- Use a vacuum or duster to remove dust and dirt from the heater and vent areas.
- Clean the exterior of the fireplace with a slightly damp cloth or duster.

Maintenance
